MICHIGAN EYES ON THE FOREST & FOREST SENTINEL TREE NETWORK

Do you manage a woodlot? Are you restoring forestland on your property? Maybe you just have a favorite oak tree in your yard. If so, you can join the Michigan Eyes on the Forest sentinel tree network and help monitor Michigan's forest resources and protect against potential invasive threats. Choose one tree, or several, to monitor throughout the year (2-3 times) and record your observations online. Early detection is key to effective management. Michigan residents can help in the identification of evidence of unusual decline, dieback or the presence of major invasive forest pests not yet known to be established in Michigan.
